

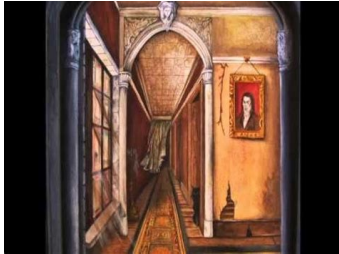


OUR MYSTERY POEM ABOUT A CREATURE
